Christ over everything Philippians 3

Verses 1-3

1. Joy is spiritual not physical.
 - a. Happiness is a physical emotion.
 - b. Sadness is a physical emotion.
 - c. Joy can be obtained whether the physical emotion is happy or sad.

Verses 4-6

Paul had all the right stuff.

Verses 7-8

And none of it mattered.

2. Joy is obtained and sustained by Christ.
 - a. Everything else is temporary.
 - b. Even the good that we do is worthless in keeping our joy.

Paul counted, hegeomai (chapter 2:3, 6) put it in judgment and thought it to be nothing for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus the Lord.

Verses 9-12

He wanted to be found having Christ's righteousness.

What is the expression of this righteousness? Faith.

#7 Intellectual Ecstasy - Christ over Everything

The word for know used here is ginowsko. This word is the primary word used in the N.T. for knowledge. This is an experiential knowledge. Not knowledge from experience, but a knowledge that brings experience. And what experience did it bring:

1. The power of Christ's resurrection
2. The fellowship of His sufferings
3. Being made conformable to His death

He was entirely joined to the Gospel in His experience but had not accomplished or achieved all that the Gospel entails, but this was His reason for living.

Intellectual Ecstasy is submitting to Christ over Everything.

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
