  - b. They don't wilt.
  - c. They prosper. (They continue producing fruit, and staying green).
2. The ungodly are not like this.

    - i. The fruit escapes them.
    - ii. They are blown away and not useful.
  - b. The ungodly will not stand in the judgment.
    - i. They fear judgment.
    - ii. They flee judgment.
    - iii. They are condemned in judgment.

    - i. They will be weeded out.
      1. When judged they did not stand, now they have no dwelling with the righteous.
